

PROCEEDINGS OF SITTING HELD ON 8.08.2019 AT 2.00 P.M CHAIRED BY SMT MAYA CHINTAMN IVNATE HON'BLE MEMBER, NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR SCHEDULED TRIBES (NCST) IN THE CASE OF SHRI JAGDISH JANGALU MALI (DISTT. AURANGABAD), S/O LATE JANGALU SHAMA MALI, MEMORIAL ATTENDANT ARCHAEOLOGICAL SURVEY OF INDIA REGARDING COMPASSIONATE APPOINTMENT.


Date of Sitting: 8.08.2019

During the Sitting the petitioner Shri Jagdish Janglu Mali, (Village + Post – Kankori, Tehsil- Gangapur, Distt.- Aurangabad) has raised grievances of denial of compassionate appointment in the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI), Aurangabad. He stated that his father namely late Shri Janglu Sama Mali, Monument Attendant at Ajanta caves, Aurangabad Circle, Aurangabad expired on 23.08.2007 and thereafter he submitted an application on 21.02.2008 to the ASI authority for providing the compassionate appointment. However, the ASI authority has refused to provide the compassionate appointment on the grounds on his marital status. He has also alleged that the Commission's recommendations made during the Sitting held on 17.08.2017 has not been implemented by the ASI authorities.

2. The Director (Admn.), Archaeological Survey of India presented the facts of the case and has also submitted an action taken report. He informed that on receipt of the petitioner's complete application from the ASI field unit, the case of Shri Jagdish Janglu Mali for compassionate appointment was considered by the Departmental Selection Committee (DSC) in meeting held on 10 and 11 December, 2014. However, his case was rejected by the DSC on the ground of being married son as per instructions of DoPT.


3. Later on, DoPT vide OM dated 05.09.2016 has clarified that since the cases of compassionate appointment rejected solely on the ground of marital status during the

intervening period i.e. 30.05.2013 to 25.02.2015, his case may be reopened/reconsidered against vacancies occurring after issue of the said OM. Accordingly, the case of Shri. Jagdish Jangalu Mali for compassionate appointment was once again placed before the DSC in its meetings held on 27.09.2017 & 26.02.2018. The Committee evaluated each case based on the criteria of selection fixed for this purpose in line with the guidelines of DoPT and prepared a merit list of the applicants. Based on his position in the merit list vis-à-vis the number of the posts available for compassionate appointment during the year the Committee has not recommended the case of Shri Jagdish Mali for compassionate appointment.

4. The case was discussed in detail. The Commission recommends that the ASI authority should reconsider the petitioner's compassionate appointment matter by placing the same in the next DSC meeting and consider for his appointment accordingly as he is from ST Community and is reported to be having a very poor financial position.

5. Action taken on the above recommendation should be provided to the Commission at the earliest.
