Minutes of sitting held in the NCST's Headquarters on 08/10/2021 at 11:00 AM under the Chairmanship of Shri Ananta Nayak, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes in the case of Shri Kora Bhadru, AAO, LIC of India, Warangal (Telangana)

List of participants is annexed.

Shri Kora Bhadru (who expired) AAO, LIC of India, Warangal (Telangana) vide representation dated 03.02.2020 has represented before the Commission that LIC not providing compulsory retirement on medical ground and non issuance of financial benefits.

A sitting was convened on 16.03.2020 by Smt. Maya Chintamn Ivnate, the then Hon'ble Member, NCST with the officers of LIC and representative of petitioner on 03.02.2020. The recommendations of the Commission were communicated to LIC for appropriate action. The LIC vide letter dated 18.05.2020 has reiterated its comments and stated that the Rules does not provide compassionate appointment to a family member on voluntary retirement of the employee. In order to provide the financial support to the family, the payments could be released soon after the receipt of discharge forms from the spouse.

The representative of petitioner not satisfied with the reply of the LIC and requested for justice. Accordingly, Shri Ananta Nayak Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Tribes has decided to discuss the issue on 08.10.2021 at 11:00 AM with the Chairman, LIC of India and the representative of petitioner (son & daughter).

The officers of LIC informed that the petitioner has filed a WP before the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana.

After detailed discussions with the officers of LIC and Ms. Tapssi D/oLate Shri Korra Bhadru, the Hon'ble Member recommends that:-

- The status of WP filed by petitioner and reply thereon filed by LIC before the Hon'ble Court should be informed by LIC to the Commission within a week.
- 2. The heirs of Shri Korra Bhadru were advised to submit the Discharge Forms prescribed by the LIC for claiming the terminal dues and interest there on amounting to more than Rs. 39 Lakhs in favors of deceased lying with LIC.

Keeping the financial condition of the Complainant and his family and the fact that deceased employee worked in the establishment for around 30 years, The LIC may consider the appointment of Shri K. Arun (S/o Shri Korra Bhadru) as an outsource basis in the LIC.

An Action Taken Report on the aforesaid recommendations may be submitted to the Commission within 30 days.
