

2. Representation dated 25.08.2013 was received from Shri Jail Singh Meena of Chhavani ward no. 16, Neem ka Thana, District Sikar, Rajasthan alleging that electric connection to the tube well on his agricultural land was disconnected by the Ajmer Vidyut Vitaran Nigam Ltd. In 2006 and the same was not being restored by the Nigam, although he has made payment of all subsequent bills also raised by the Nigam.

Discussions

3. The representatives of the Ajmer Vidyut Vitaran Nigam Ltd. (Jhunjhunu Division) submitted a written reply dated 21/07/2015 in the Sitting. The Officials of the AVVNL explained that an electric connection with 5 HP load was working since 17.02.1983 in the name and on the land of Shri Prabhu Dayal Meena, S/o Shri Khamana Ram Meena. It was alleged in the application dated 13.06.2013 of the petitioner that the power supply to his tube well was cut off for about 15 years. He had requested to restore the power connection to the tube well. Inquiry into the complaint conducted by the concerned Junior Engineer revealed that power cables to the tube well through all the four electric poles were missing and the same was promptly intimated to the complainant. The Junior Engineer had suggested for restoration of electric connection to the tube well from the Rural Feeder by installing new cables and a new transformer and work order was also issued accordingly. However, installing new cables through existing electric poles was not possible as per rules as the cable would pass over the residential area built on the agricultural land of Late Shri Prabhu Dayal Meena. Moreover, the land was under various disputes, including one case in the Rajasthan High Court, between various claimants of the land after the death of Shri Prabhu Dayal Meena. Since the passing of power cable over residential area is not permitted, it is not possible to provide power cables through the original electric poles. Accordingly, a new plan for electrification of the tube well by laying the power cables along the land of Late Shri Prabhu Dayal Meena was prepared and work order was also issued. But the complainant did not allow the staff of AVVNL to execute the work order.
