You are required to bring with you the connected documents for examination by the National Commission.

**Case reference :** Representation dated 16.09.2021 received from Dr. H.K. Nagu, Vice President, Akhil Bharatiya Vanvashi Kalyan Ashram, Hyderabad regarding atrocity against 41 Koya Scheduled Tribe families of Seetaigudem Village, Chandrugonda Mandal of KG District, Telangana by the Forest Officials and local Police Officials by way of eviction from the forest land, brutally beaten and damaged cotton crops - action against accused under Atrocity Act - Not receiving action taken report on the Commission's recommendations.

If you fail to comply with this order without lawful excuse, you shall be subjected to the consequences of non-attendance laid down in Rule 12 of Order XVI of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.
