Case reference: Representation dated 03.06.2022 of Smt. Lamba Laxmi, W/o Shri Krishnayya, R/o Poppangi Tribal Village, Chinnakittalapadu Panchayat, Saravakota Mandal, Srikakulam District (AP) regarding caste abuse, illegal grabbing of land, brutal attack, causing life threat with deadly weapons and Police inaction against accused.

If you fail to comply with this order without lawful excuse, you shall be subjected to the consequences of non-attendance laid down in Rule 12 of Order XVI of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.
