NEW DELHI, THE2022

- **G.S.R.** In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of "Despatch Rider" in the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes, namely: -
- 1. Short title and commencement. (1) These rules may be called the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes, Despatch Rider (Group C) Recruitment Rules, 2022.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Application. These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these Rules.
- 3. Number of Posts, Classification, and level in pay matrix. The number of said post, its classification and the Pay Level in Pay Matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.
- 4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification etc.- The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
- 5. Disqualification. No person, -
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
 - (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 6. Power to relax. Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 7. Saving. Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen or any other special categories of persons in

accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Such persons would be given deputation terms upto the date on which they are due for release from the Armed Forces; thereafter they may be continued on re-employment:

Note 1: For purposes of appointment on deputation/absorption basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1.1.2016/the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 7th CPC recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay/pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade

pay/pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay/pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.

Note 2: The period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years.

Note 3: The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding fifty-six years as on the closing date of receipt or applications.
